Thursday, June 20, 2019 – Tour to Arizona State Museum

This tour will depart the Hilton Inn in Tucson by 1:30 p.m. and travel across the city to the University of Arizona Campus and location of the Arizona State Museum. At the museum take a docent guided tour and explore the museum collections on your own. The bus will return to the hotel by 4:30 p.m.
