

## **2018 WWA Convention tours**

***WWA will offer two organized tours this year.***

### **Thursday, June 21, 2018 – Tour to Chief Plenty Coups State Park, Pryor, Montana**

This tour will depart the DoubleTree hotel in Billings promptly at noon, with each attendee having a box lunch to eat on the bus ride down to Chief Plenty Coups State Park. Once at the park, our group will divide into three smaller groups for the actual tour with time spent in the visitor center, in the collections area, and on the land and in the house that once belonged to Crow Chief Plenty Coups. Expect to do a limited amount of walking on uneven ground. We will board buses at 4 p.m. for the one-hour drive back to the hotel. (**Note:** *For this tour we have no access to an ADA accessible bus*)

### **Saturday, June 23, 2018 – Tour to Buffalo Bill Center of the West, Cody, Wyoming**

This tour will depart Billings and the DoubleTree hotel promptly at 8 a.m. for the drive down to Cody, Wyoming. We will provide breakfast snacks. The tour will arrive at the Buffalo Bill Center of the West in Cody at 10 a.m. where docents will provide orientation and some guided activities. Lunch is included and there will be plenty of time to explore the McCracken Research Library, which houses our Western Writers Hall of Fame, plus the museums of BBCOW: Plains Indian Museum, Cody Firearms Museum, Draper Museum of Natural History, Buffalo Bill Museum, and Whitney Western Art Museum. If you want to explore a bit of downtown Cody, you can walk there in 10 minutes, or catch the Cody Trolley. The buses will load to leave the BBCOW promptly at 3 p.m. for the drive back to Billings.
